



TRE MONTE

Many years ago, Mount Rekewa was acquired by a geologist who opened his gold mine, "Los Coipos".

Located on the Tremonte Estate, the mine was eventually abandoned and has remained closed for the past 30 years.

The vines from this area are among the highest above sea level in Chile—so high, in fact, that during the winter months, they are sometimes lost among the clouds.

From a humble family farm in Abruzzo, Italy, to a commercial winery on the slopes of Mount Rekewa in Chile, a winemaking tradition spans the globe and stretches across generations for a local resident of Thunder Bay, Canada.

“We were farmers in Italy; we came here and went into construction,” says Silvio Di Gregorio, president of Northern Vintages and Tremonte Boutique Vineyard, with a laugh. “But there is always that desire to return to your roots.”

That desire to return to his family roots led Di Gregorio on a journey of global opportunities, deciding to found Tremonte Winery in 2009 on an existing vineyard in Chile’s fertile Central Valley. Di Gregorio and his business partners developed the vineyard over the years, expanding the grape varieties and building production facilities on the property that can currently store up to two million liters of wine.

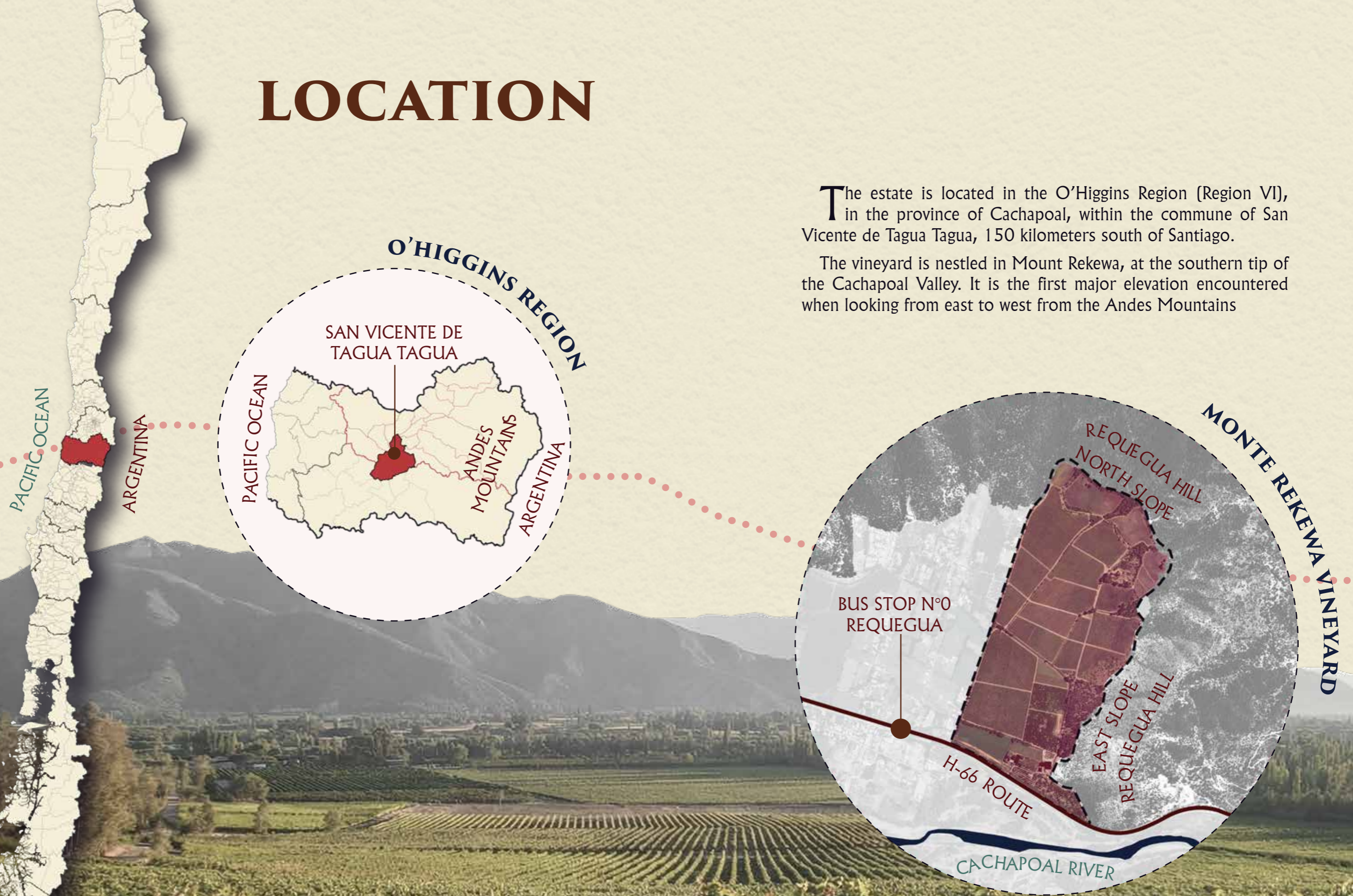

LOCATION

The estate is located in the O'Higgins Region (Region VI), in the province of Cachapoal, within the commune of San Vicente de Tagua Tagua, 150 kilometers south of Santiago.

The vineyard is nestled in Mount Rekewa, at the southern tip of the Cachapoal Valley. It is the first major elevation encountered when looking from east to west from the Andes Mountains



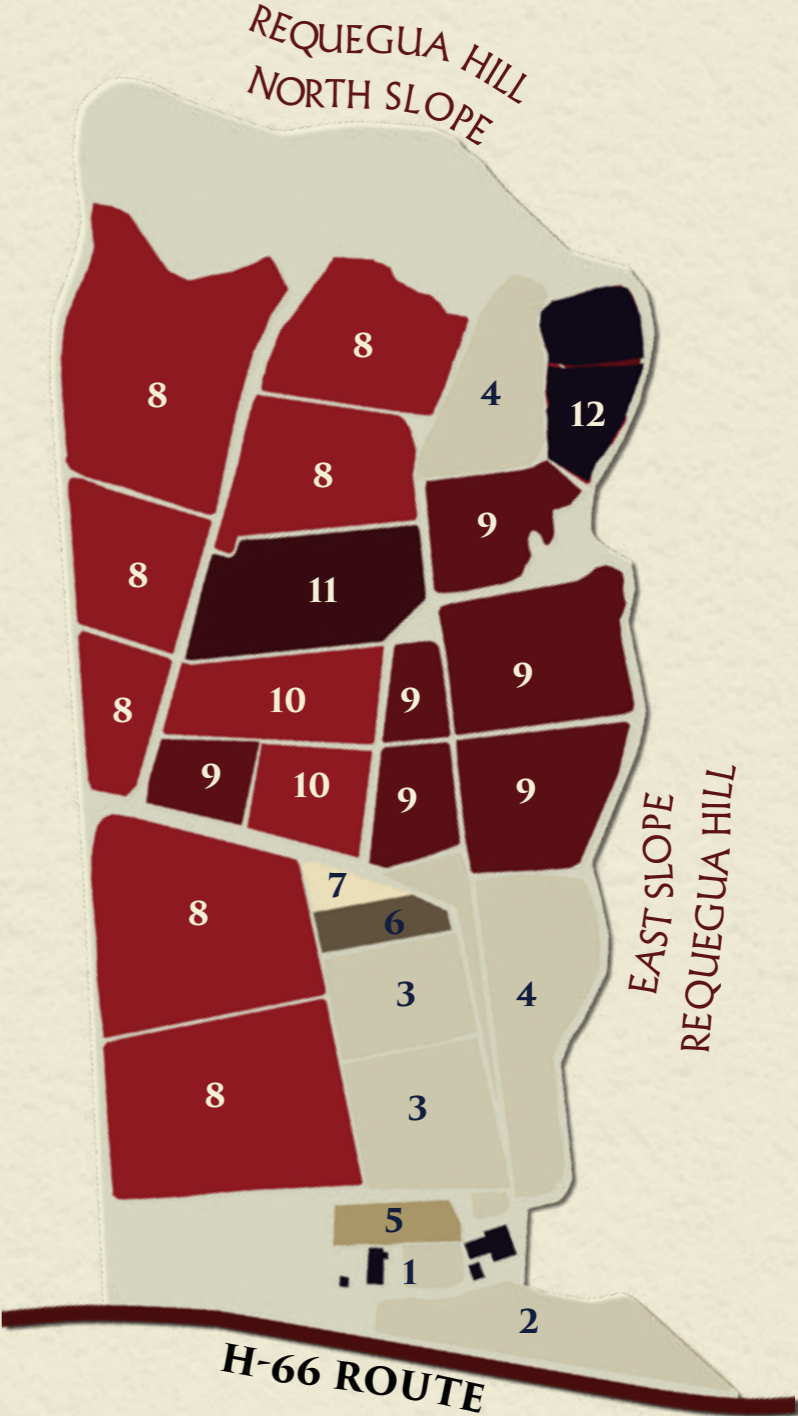
THE ESTATE

The estate features rocky piedmont soils, making it ideal for the production of expressive and concentrated wines. Steep slopes ranging from 45° to 51° result in slower ripening and lower water retention, leading to the production of smaller, more concentrated grapes. It is an extreme vineyard, with elevations fluctuating between 300 and 500 meters above sea level.

The climate is delightful during the ripening months, with daytime temperatures around 30°C that drop to 14°C at night. The refreshing Andean afternoon breeze helps prevent temperatures from soaring.

The grape varieties planted on the estate include Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere, Malbec, Merlot, Syrah, and Viognier. Additionally, there are blocks of fruit trees and native forests characteristic of the mountainside.

VINEYARDS

The steep, rocky slopes of Mount Rekewa, with gradients ranging from 45 to 51 degrees, provide the perfect terrain for producing premium red grapes. The vineyard features a drip irrigation system fed by a source originating from an Andean glacier. Summer afternoon breezes descending from the Andes Mountains cool the vineyard, promoting a slow ripening of the grapes.

These conditions are ideal for cultivating premium reds, highlighting our specialties

Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah.



PRODUCTION

Nestled between the mountains and the pulse of life stands our modern production facility—a precision structure capable of housing up to two million liters. Here, engineering is placed at the service of enology, guarding the vibrant character of our high-altitude grapes in stainless steel



BARRELS

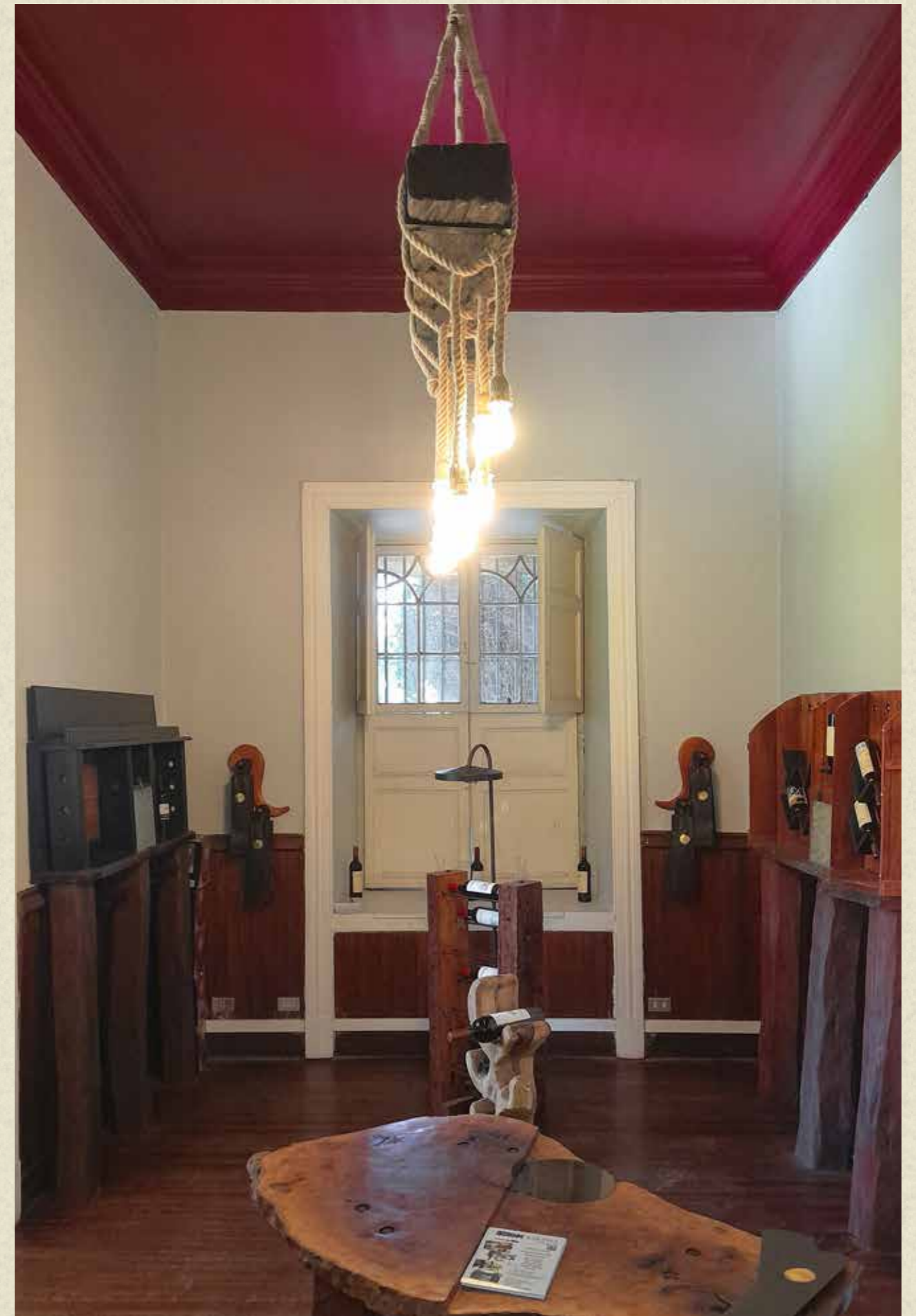
We use small eco-friendly vats and the finest hand-selected French oak barrels to craft our wines.

Built with adobe, the structure is highlighted by its roof, which still preserves original colonial-era tiles. Even on the hottest days, the barrel room remains remarkably cool and dark—the perfect environment for aging wines in oak

TREMONTE

Chile is one of the most beautiful and diverse countries in the world; it is home to the driest desert on Earth, some of the highest mountains in the Southern Hemisphere, and ancient glaciers that culminate at the planet's southernmost continental point before Antarctica.

Tremonte reflects the unique soil and climate characteristics of the mountains that directly influence the estate: the Andes Mountains, the Coastal Range, and Mount Rekewa—the latter giving rise to the vineyard and its diverse grape varieties.
